

SEC -1 in Spoken English.

Syllabus .

Course objective: The course aims at enhancing communicative skills as well as skills in presentation and survey activities in academic and professional fields .

Full Marks 50. ESE (Practical) 35, CE 15.

Unit 1 . The sounds of English. Pronunciation of Words and Everyday phrases. Preliminary level phonetics. 15 marks

Unit 2. Spoken Skills: Greetings, Introducing oneself, Everyday phrases and responses. Asking questions, Giving answers. 10 marks

Unit 3. Vocabulary and Word Recognition. Basic ideas about parts of speech; number, gender in nouns and pronouns. Oral Expression of the Language: Brief Story-telling, Narrating a local event, Interviews. 10 marks.

Note: Unit 2 and Unit 3 can be practised as group activity and may be evaluated so.

SEC 2 in Spoken English .

Syllabus.

Course Objective: This second course in Spoken English aims at enhancing the skills gathered and learnt in SEC 1 toward more specific practical and professional needs

Full Marks...50. ESE (practical) 35. CE 15.

Unit 1. Condensation of sentences ...one word substitutions for larger phrases. Tense of verbs, change of tense. (all to be practised and evaluated in oral-aural medium). 15 marks

Unit 2. Group activity...Mock Interview, Mock sales persuasion of products. 10 marks

Unit 3. Reading News Headlines. News Reading. 10 marks.
