VIDEOGRAPHY (SEC – 01):

35 Marks

- Visualising news/ Electronic News Gathering (ENG) research, investigation interview techniques: piece to camera and voice over, sequencing and editing news
 packages.
- Videography Basics Colour/ White balance, basic shots, camera movements and camera angles, multi camera shooting. Planning location shoots.
- Planning studio Videography —using reflectors, lighting grid, luminaries. Studio lighting.

PHOTOGRAPHY (SEC -02):

- principal focus & focal length, size of images, intensity of images, Types of lens-Wide angle, Telephoto and Zoom, speed of lenses, depth of field, depth of focus, factors controlling of depth of field & focus, variation of aperture with distance of subject, defects of images- chromatic and spherical aberration, curvature of field, distortion astigmatism.
