The Registrar (Addl. Charge), Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University invites bids through the West Bengal Government e-procurement system "https://wbtenders.gov.in". Online bids are invited from reliable, resourceful, bonafide, and experienced firms/companies/individual contractors/labour contract cooperatives having the requisite financial capability and adequate technical credentials for executing similar types of work. 12.	Important Instructions	 The financial bid documents of the technically qualified bidders will only be opened. The Registrar (Addl. Charge) reserves the right to reject or cancel any or all pre-qualification documents and bid document without assigning any reasons whatsoever. All duties, taxes, royalties, cess, including 1% cess under W.B. Building and other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employments & Condition of Service) Act, 1996], toll, taxes and other levies payable by the Contractor under the Contract to the State / Central Government for any other cause, shall be included in the rates, prices and total Bid price submitted by the bidder. 1% Cess under W.B. Building and other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employments & Condition of Service) Welfare Cess Act, 1996 will be deducted from the running bills. To keep the work in good condition during the next 1(one) years after the completion of the construction work if any additional / excess work is required over the stipulated quantity in the schedule for routine maintenance work, the same will be treated as defect liability and the Contractor has to do the maintenance work at his own cost. The intending bidders are requested to inspect the work site before quoting their rates.

INFORMATION TO THE BIDDERS

1.1 FINANCIAL BID:

1. A single rate (percentage above, below, or at par) shall be quoted in the specified space of the BOQ provided under the financial bid.



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- 2. The rate quoted by the tenderer shall be inclusive of all taxes, duties, and levies. The tenderer shall include Income Tax, Sales Tax, Service Tax, Cess, Octroi (if any), toll, ferry charges, local charges, royalties, turnover tax, and all other applicable charges while quoting the rate.
- 3. All other charges, such as insurance, freight, etc., required for completion of the work, shall also be included in the quoted rate. No claim in this regard shall be entertained later.
- 4. If the lowest rate quoted is below 20% of the estimated value, performance security @2.0% of the contract value shall be submitted in the form of a Demand Draft in favour of the Registrar, Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University, along with acceptance of the Letter of Intent. The same will be released immediately after completion of the work.

1.2 Taxes & Duties to be borne by the Contractor:

It is reiterated that Income Tax, GST, Sales Tax, Royalty, Construction Workers' Welfare Cess, and all similar statutory levies/cess shall be borne by the contractor while executing the work.

1.3 Site Inspection before Submission of Tender:

Before submitting the tender, the intending tenderer shall acquaint themselves thoroughly with the local site conditions through actual inspection and consider all factors and difficulties likely to be involved in the execution of work. No claim shall be entertained later on this account. No extension of completion period or modification of work will ordinarily be allowed on the grounds of site conditions. Therefore, bidders should carefully study the site before submitting their bids.

1.3.1 Conditional and Incomplete Tenders:

Conditional and incomplete tenders shall be summarily rejected.

2. Acceptance of Tender:

The lowest valid rate may be accepted; however, the undersigned reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason.

3. Payment:

Progressive and stage-wise payment will be made depending upon the executed work, as follows:

Sl. No.	Payment Bill	Stage of Completion of Work
1	1st RA Bill	After execution of 50% of the Contract Amount
2	2nd & Final Bill	After execution of the balance work and successful completion of the scheme

- Payment of RA as well as the final bill will depend on fund availability. No financial claim for delay in payment will be entertained.
- No bidder may hamper the progress of work by citing non-payment of bills. The financial
 capability of the bidder is evaluated through annual turnover, and non-payment shall not be
 accepted as a reason for delay or slow progress. The authority may impose a penalty for delayed
 completion.

4. Security Deposit:

4.1 The bidder shall be required to properly maintain the work, including all components, for a period of 01 (one) year from the date of completion recorded in the MB. A total of 10% of the contract amount shall be deducted progressively from each RA bill as Security Deposit. The EMD shall be adjusted with the Security Deposit. Release of the S.D. shall be subject to satisfactory quality and maintenance during the security period. Failure to maintain the work shall lead to forfeiture of the S.D.



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- 4.2 The contractor must apply for release of the S.D. in the prescribed format at least 2 (two) months prior to the end of the defect liability period, with an undertaking that the work has been maintained as per contract terms.
- 4.3 The Security Deposit shall be released after 1 (one) year from the completion of the work. Any minor or major repair during the security period shall be carried out by the contractor. If the contractor fails to do so, the cost will be recovered from the S.D. retained by the authority.

5. Withdrawal of Tender:

A tender, once submitted, shall not be withdrawn within 120 days from the date of opening of the financial bid. If a tenderer withdraws without valid reason within this period, the EMD shall be forfeited.

6. Other Terms & Conditions:

6.1 Labour Welfare:

- The contractor shall abide by all labour welfare laws and their amendments, including the Minimum Wages Act, E.S.I., P.F., Bonus, and other facilities as per the latest government order/circular.
- Under no circumstances shall the Registrar (Addl. Charge) be held responsible for any issues, including payment of wages to personnel deployed by the contractor.

6.2:

Bidders are requested to remain present during the opening of the technical and financial bids. In the absence of any bidder, the undersigned reserves the right to open the technical and financial bids. 6.3

The tender accepting authority may ask any tenderer to submit rate analysis for justification.

6.4

Original copies of all certificates shall be produced for verification upon request by the Registrar (Addl. Charge).

7. Agreement:

The contractor whose tender is accepted shall, within 15 (fifteen) days of receipt of intimation, obtain an additional set of contract documents and submit the same duly signed for formal agreement. Failure to comply shall result in cancellation of acceptance and forfeiture of EMD.

8. Work Execution:

- **Penalty:** Time is the essence of the contract. Any delay shall attract a penalty @ 0.5% per week of delay, subject to a maximum of 10% of the unexecuted portion of the work.
- Work shall commence within 7 days of receipt of the Work Order, failing which the Work Order shall be cancelled and EMD forfeited.
- After receiving the Work Order, the contractor shall submit a work programme and bar chart, establish a site office, and deploy a Site Engineer. Work Order, drawings, schedules, and tools & tackles shall be maintained at site for supervision.
- Steel shall be of **SAIL**, **TATA**, or other ISI-approved brands, and cement shall be from **ACC**, **Ultratech**, **Ambuja**, or other approved brands. Original test certificates must be produced.
- Qualified engineers shall be deployed to ensure quality works. If substandard work is detected, the authority may direct re-execution, check qualifications, or impose penalties.



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- Sub-letting of the work is strictly prohibited. An undertaking must be given that the job will not be sub-let. Violation will lead to termination of contract and forfeiture of S.D.
- All materials and workmanship shall conform to approved standards and methodology.

8.2 Payment:

- No advance payment shall be made.
- The contractor shall pay minimum wages to workers in the presence of engineers. Bills shall be processed only after certification of wage payment.

8.3 Cost Escalation:

No cost escalation will be allowed after issuance of the Work Order.

8.4 Defect Liability Period:

The defect liability period starts from the date of completion of the work. Release of Security Money (10%) will be calculated accordingly.

8.5 Termination of Contract:

The authority may terminate the contract in cases of:

- i) Poor progress of work.
- ii) Poor quality of work.
- iii) Use of unfair means.
- iv) Violation/non-compliance of instructions.
- A 7-day notice shall be issued for rectification of deficiencies. If not complied, the contract will be terminated, and EMD, S.D., and performance security forfeited.

8.6 Discretion of the Authority:

The authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning reasons. The BOQ quantities are provisional and subject to change. The Registrar (Addl. Charge) may reduce quantities substantially without compensation.
