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❖ Biography:

I completed my B.A. (2011) & M.A. (2013) in Sanskrit (Specialization in *Navya Vyākaraṇa*) from Ramakrishna Mission Vidyamandira, Belur Math, Howrah, affiliated to the University of Calcutta, Kolkata, West Bengal, India. After that, I have obtained Ph.D. degree in Sanskrit language from the University of Calcutta (2014 - 2018) on Titled: *Śābdikanaye Śābdabodhasahakārikāraṇavimarśaḥ* (*Deliberation of Secondary Causes of the Verbal Cognition according to the Sanskrit Grammarians*) under the supervision of late Prof. Satyabrata Pahari, Department of Sanskrit, Ramakrishna Mission Vidyamandira, Belur Math, Howrah, West Bengal. I had been an UGC Senior Research Fellow (SRF). Since 1st December 2016, I have been serving in a substantive post as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Sanskrit in Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University, Cooch Behar, West Bengal, India till date.

Panini's '<i>Aṣṭādhyāyī</i>' is a unique work in the history of Sanskrit grammar, well known to all. However, the composition of grammar did not cease with the '<i>Aṣṭādhyāyī</i>.' Even after the '<i>Aṣṭādhyāyī</i>,' works such as '<i>Kātantra</i>,' '<i>Mugdhabodha</i>,' and '<i>Sārasvata</i>' occupy significant places in the history of Sanskrit grammar. Yet, some grammar books are not as universally recognized or popular. One such grammar is '<i>Prayogaratnamālā Vyākaraṇam</i>,' authored by Puruṣottamavidyāvāgīśa. This grammar was composed in <i>kārikā</i> style and was first published in 1890 AD. It was later printed in 1894 AD by Sri Siddhanāth Vidyāvāgīśa, a resident of Khagaravati village in Coochbehar, West Bengal. This grammar book was printed in Bengali script by the royal press of Coochbehar. Printed in Bengali script, this book is currently unavailable in physical form; it exists solely in PDF format on the internet archive. Given the necessity to transcribe this work into Devanāgarī script, a comparative analysis with Panini's <i>Aṣṭādhyāyī</i> should also be included.
